Proud of our town

Carman was settled in 1870 when Winnipeg settlers used the Missouri Trail to locate around the Boyne River.

Businesses began to open in 1878 and it was during this period of growth that the settlers became interested in founding and properly naming a village on their Boyne site.

A vote was taken and Carman City was chosen, later shortened to Carman, after Episcopal Methodist Church bishop Rev. Albert Carman.

Located at the junction of Highways 3 and 13, just 40 minutes southwest of Winnipeg, Carman is situated in the heart of a rich prairie agricultural belt and just 100 kilometres north of the United States border.

Incorporated as a town in 1905, the community served as an agricultural, manufacturing and commercial service centre to the surrounding area, a role it continues today.

Carman has a population of 3,206 but serves a market area of more than 15,000. Administered by the Town of Carman council and staff, it shares many services and costs with the surrounding authority of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin.

Strong Dutch and Mennonite influences give Carman a unique and vibrant cultural mixture of faiths, business and community involvement.

From producing national bowling champions and Hall of Fame Goldeyes baseball teams, to world champion sailor Kelly Hand, NHL Olympian Eddie "The

Eagle" Belfour, Nikki Beare — the first captain of Canada's National Junior Women's Hockey Team — and record-setting curler Shaela Hayward, who became the first Manitoban to win three provincial curling championships in a single season, Carman is serious when it comes to sports.

Carman has hosted numerous provincial events in a wide variety of sports. Hockey, curling, bowling, the MSOS Games and the 1990 and 2008 Manitoba Games!

As with most communities this size, local residents are proud of their sports history.

Many attribute Carman's unique characters to its successful integration of old to new architecture and its cultural makeup. Stately old homes, the Memorial Hall, clock tower and other heritage buildings reflect a town with a sense of history, while the modern

hospital and ultra-modern condominium projects demonstrate a community with 21st-century priorities.

We invite you to read on, then come and see for yourself why Carman is a great place to visit, live and do business. You'll discover a town with a past and a community with a future. ■

Accommodations

With bed and breakfasts and hotels ready to meet your accommodation needs, spending time in Carman means plenty of rest and relaxation in country comfort once the day is done.

Blue Crescent Hotel has 30 rooms with a lot to offer. Hotel amenities

include uniquely designed rooms, family rooms with bunks, team/meeting room, sports equipment storage rooms, a pool and waterslide. If you're ever in the area, stop in and see what big features this small town hotel has.



Located in downtown Carman, the **Carman Motor Inn** is a hotel offering 15 modern rooms, VLTs and an extra-large beverage room and dance floor featuring DJ and live-band entertainment.

Your home away from home is here too, so choose a bed and breakfast host.

A B&B with history is the **Bell Aura Bed, Breakfast & Bistro**, located in

a 100-year-old Presbyterian church. A bed and breakfast filled with history and character, Bell Aura boasts original stained-glass windows, antique furnishings and original art. They also offer catering services and the use of their facilities to host

gatherings, dinners, special events, etc.

If it's outdoor livin' you're lookin' for, look at **King's Park Campground**. Located on PR245 and King's Park Rd. there are 40 sites with 30-amp service. Located in our park are two picnic shelters. The large picnic shelter, located near the Kin Splash Zone, includes water, electricity and the outdoor BBQ pit (propane not provided). These facilities are designed for outdoor gatherings that provide shade, and protection from the rain. The small picnic shelter is located by King Park's Playground and the Carman Aquatic Centre. This shelter has water and electricity but no BBQ Pit.

There are also two large unserviced areas and washrooms on-site, all only steps from the pool, tennis courts, golf course, baseball

diamonds, beach volleyball, horseshoe pits and the museum. The campground's number is 204-745-2684.

A short 10-minute ride from Carman, another recreation facility awaits.

Stephenfield Provincial Park, located on Stephenfield Lake, offers swimming, boating,

Sites to See

Vanderveen's Greenhouses, located west of Carman, has 23 acres of greenhouses. Flowers are in bloom for Christmas, Easter and Mother's Day and in spring, acres of bedding plants fill the greenhouses. They are a must-see during these seasons.

The Community Pathway to Active Living winds its way throughout Carman and is available to all residents and visitors. It provides a scenic river path for walking, jogging, biking, cross-country skiing and links to recreation areas but also features Carman's tall Grass Prairie. Initially planted in 1996 by the Botany Department, several studies on grasses and insects are ongoing by the Department

of Agriculture. Today less than one per cent of the original tallgrass prairie in Manitoba remains. More natural beauty can be found at King's Park or Ryall Park. Well-treed and spacious, on any given day you can find someone taking a walk, enjoying a picnic or reading a book in the rest areas. The pathway passes by an outdoor gym for all ages.

There is more history to be found at Dufferin Historical Museum located at 20 King's Park Road. The museum is open Tuesday – Saturday 10 – 5 and Sunday 1-5 in June – August or by appointment. This museum is bigger than it looks! They boast a number of artifacts including displays related to sports, medical, Indigenous people, kitchen, Religion and War, a furnished

1870's log house and a fully restored one room school house.

The Boyne Regional Library occupies a designated municipal heritage building, formerly the town's post office. The exterior combines Manitoba Tyndall stone and brick. The clock tower houses the building's original timepiece made by A.E. Joyce and Co. of Whitechurch, England. The library has had several expansions throughout the years. The most recent expansion was in 2020 after years of planning and fundraising. The library has a large collection and offers a variety of services and programs. Today, the Boyne Regional Library is one of the busiest rural libraries in Manitoba.

Ryall Park

The **Memorial Hall** was constructed in 1919 in memory of the Carman and Dufferin residents who fought in the First World War. The hall was renovated in 1996-97 and rededicated in 1997. The Hall was completely renovated in 2015-16 but kept enough history including a veteran Memorial Room. It houses the Town of Carman and Dufferin municipal offices.

The **Bell Aura Bed, Breakfast & Bistro** is housed in an over 100-year old former Presbyterian Church and includes the original stained-glass windows imported from Scotland.

The **Carman United Church** is still very active after 100 years.

Because of Carman keeping in touch with its past, the town has been the site of at least three made-for-television movie shoots in recent years.

If you like hockey history, stop in at the arena to see **Carman's Hall of Fame** display, which features memorabilia of local heroes including NHLers Eddie "the Eagle" Belfour and Jim McFadden, both Calder Cup winners.

Shopping is always a popular pastime and Carman offers a variety of specialty stores for you to enjoy.

Golden Prairie Arts Council in the historic CN station, 38 Centre Ave W. in Carman. GPAC offers a wide assortment of arts and cultural programs year-round including classes, workshops, concerts and performances. In addition to a variety of exhibitions throughout the year in their on-site gallery, GPAC also has local and regional artists' works and wares available in the gift shop year-round.

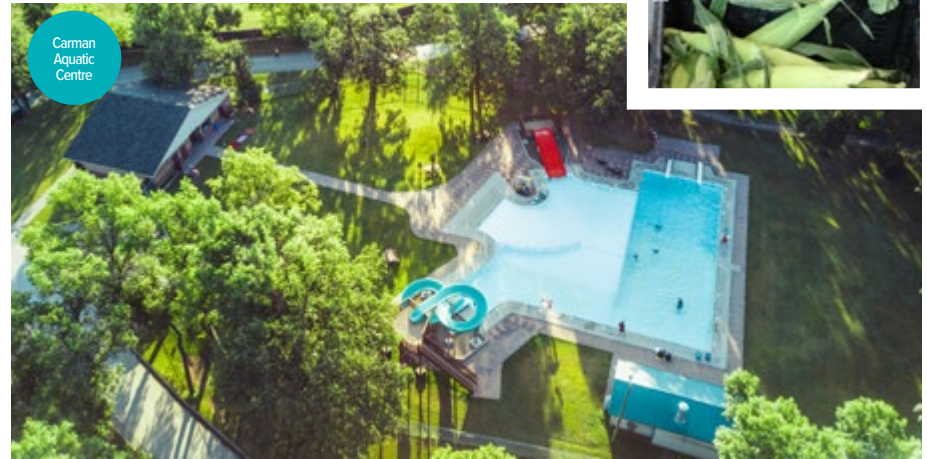
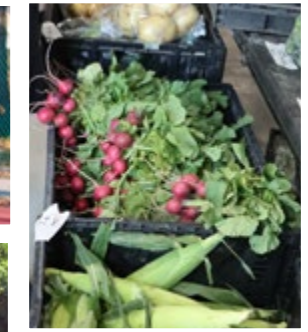

Carman Aquatic Centre

The **Carman Aquatic Centre** is located in **King's Park**, nestled between the campground, golf club, tennis courts and playground. It features a heated area, two slides, two diving boards and a modern change house.

The **Kin Splash Zone** in **King's Park** is a 2800 sq. ft. splash pad that is free and has gentle water features including an interactive water table for younger children, plus a more exciting space for older children with dumping buckets, spray loops, blasters and much more!

An 18-hole golf course that is the talk of southern Manitoba, leads the list of Carman's recreation attractions. **Carman Golf & Curling Club's** many outstanding features includes the newest attraction, Disc Golf, as well as the clubhouse facility which includes a pro shop. The course hosts plenty of men's, ladies and mixed fun tournaments throughout the summer. Within 15 minutes of Carman, there are also courses in Roland, Elm Creek and Miami.

Come relax at **King's Park**, featuring a large heated outdoor swimming pool, playground, tennis courts and skate park. The park is also the site of the **Dufferin Historical Museum**, which includes two original heritage buildings... Sexsmith log cabin and the Boyne School.

The **Carman Dufferin Recreation** runs a summer drop-in program that will keep your youngsters amused and entertained while you fill your day with shopping and touring. The **King's Park Campground** features 40 sites and on-site washrooms, all only steps away from all facilities, including the pool.

Located west of Carman, **Stephenfield Provincial Park** offers a beach, cooking facilities, fishing, boat launch and 177 secluded campsites, including 44 seasonal sites and 6 Yurts. This park is the site of the Carman Game and Fish Derby in May.

The **Birch Ski Area**, also located west of Carman off PR 245 features a network of tree-lines trails perfect for cross-country running, hiking and mountain biking.

Boyne River Keepers welcomes you to kayak, canoe, or paddleboard on the beautiful Boyne River at any time that suits you. You will be in a different world! The **Trestle Bridge Dock** and **Ryall Park Launch** are both suited for launching watercraft. Please use at your own risk and enjoy the tranquility! Local Events

Canada's birthday is always a day to celebrate with live entertainment and activities at Carman.

In mid-July come out for the Carman Country Fair and your chance to experience an old-fashioned rural fair. One of the longest-running agricultural fairs in Manitoba – offering plenty of activities and fun for Carman visitors and residents.

The three-day event offers 4-H displays, livestock exhibits, beer gardens, kid's entertainment, daily midway rides and evening entertainment, farmer's market and sidewalk sales. Daily events and entertainment at the fairgrounds.

The fair has a parade on Saturday morning, which features floats and entries from the community and around the province.

Dufferin Historical Museum hosts Christmas at the Museum with Santa, horse drawn sled rides, treats and games for all ages.

Held the first Saturday in December, get your photo taken with Santa and enjoy a delicious meal provided by community volunteers.

Going for a slide down the **toboggan run** in King's Park is a must. No toboggan? Just get a cardboard box.

Free **public skating** is available at the arena throughout the winter. Carman offers hockey for all ages from minor to adult recreational men's and ladies.

Carman offers many kilometres of local snowmobile trails that hook up with provincial trail routes, groomed and maintained by the **Snoflies Snowmobile Club**.

The **Birch Ski Area** features a network of ski trails excellent for cross-country skiing.

The **Pumpkin Creek Ski Club**, located approximately 1.5 km west of Roseisle, offers 20 km of groomed trails for all ski skill levels.

To warm up after a day outdoors, drop in at **Carman Five-Pin Bowl** and enjoy lane luxury or at the local **Legion Branch #18**. They invite the public in for Friday night meat draws and Saturday night bingo.

Other annual fall and winter events include the **One-Stop Shop** in the Hall and **Carman Gun Show**.

Carman Run and Walk Crew meet Thursdays at 6 p.m. May 14 to October 8 at Ryall Park in Carman and use the Carman Community Pathway trails. All paces, all people.

If you like the crisp air and rosy cheeks that come with spending time outdoors during the winter, take up one of these activities.

For those who like to hurry hard, there are plenty of curling bonspiels held in Carman and the surrounding communities throughout the winter for all calibres of rockers. ■

Education

Carman is home to the Prairie Rose School Division (www.prsdmb.ca), which administers the Carman Elementary School (K-5 French Immersion), Carman Collegiate (Grades 6-12), and several schools in nearby communities. On the cutting edge of education,

the division has implemented many programs that make the best use of its resources and provide maximum benefits to its students.

Dufferin Christian School a private K-Grade 12 facility affiliated with the Canadian Reformed Church, is located just outside Carman, combines education and faith studies.

Students have registered at the Midland Adult Education Centre (MAEC) to upgrade their skills for employment or university or finish their high school diploma. The centre also offers mature student diplomas, dual credits, work experience, portfolios and resumes. ■

Retail Sector

Carman provides retail and shopping facilities to a large area, with many services available including family clothing stores, hardware, lumber, automotive parts, a cellular phone outlet, a grocery store, department stores and numerous specialty outlets.

Carman also has Ford, GM and Chrysler dealerships, a liquor store, two pharmacies, full-service gas stations, travel agents and many businesses not usually found in towns Carman's size, including professional photographers, funeral and cremation service, a self-storage facility, a computer-repair business and two car washes.

The economy of the area is evidenced by the fact that

Carman receives freight service from a number of companies and is on a rail line serviced by Central Manitoba Railway. The town is also on the routes of major trucking firms and courier services and is home to the Carman Dufferin Airport.

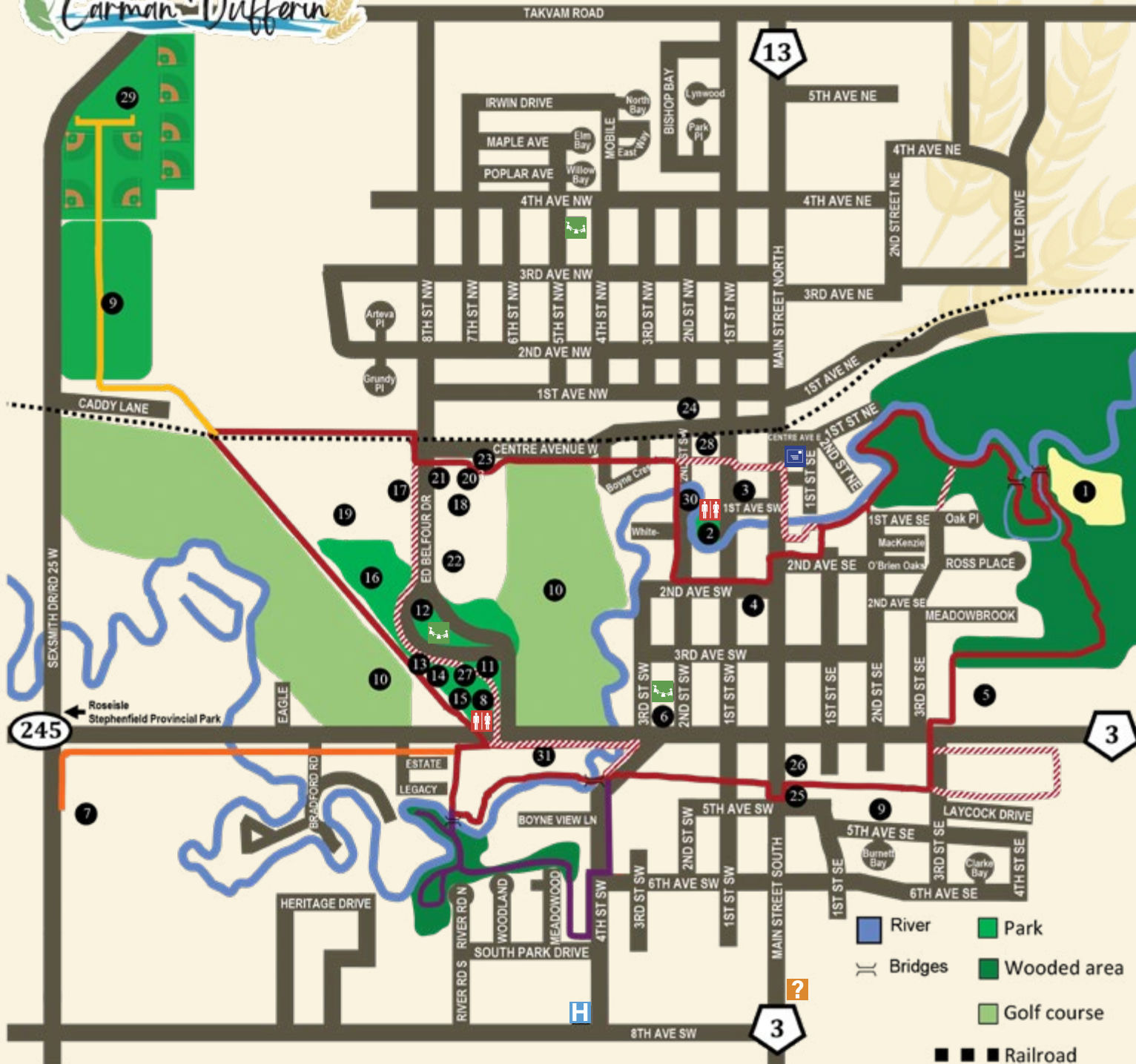

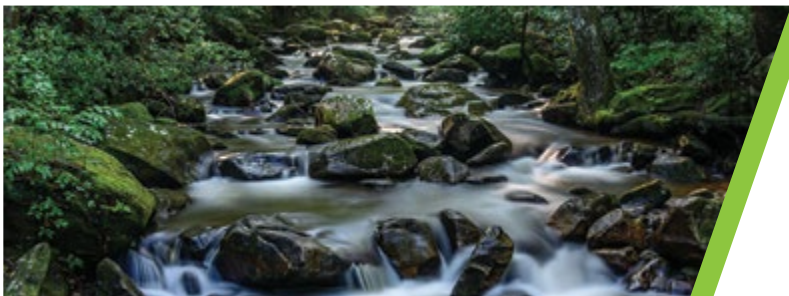
